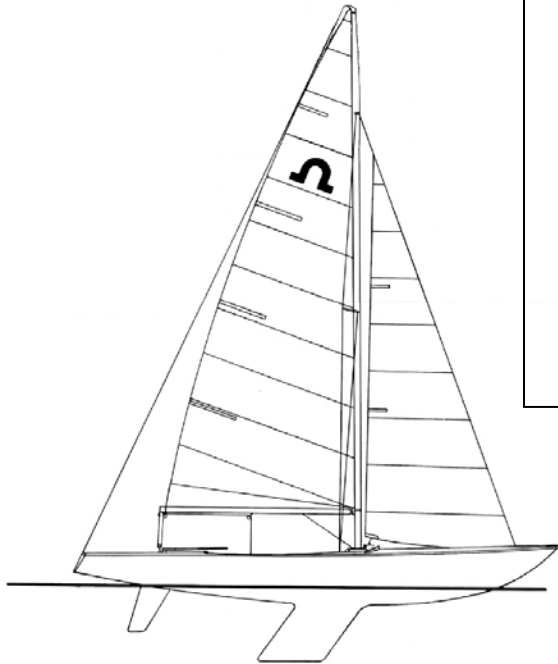


# 2018 'Not Nude' Regatta



## Notice of Race

March 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, & 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018  
Friday, Saturday & Sunday

&

The San Diego Soling Fleet

The 'Not Nude' Regatta is a ten race series in waters of Mission Bay and the Pacific Ocean. Mission Beach is a community of San Diego. The selection of venue, i.e. Mission Bay or the Pacific Ocean is dependent on the conditions on each day of the event. The regatta is intended to be sailed in the Pacific Ocean on all three days.

### 1. RULES

1.1 The 'Not Nude' Regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2017- 2020* (RRS), and the rules of the International Soling class (ISA), except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions. The prescriptions of United States Sailing will not apply.

### 2. ALTERATIONS

2.1 If there is a conflict between ISA Class Rules, this NOR, the Sailing Instructions (SI) or any additional Sailing Instructions (ASI), RRS Rule 63.7 shall apply.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The 'Not Nude' Regatta is open to all sailboats that meet Soling Class specifications.

3.2 Eligible yachts may register on the first day of racing in the Soling storage area at Mission Bay Yacht Club between 9:00 am and 10:00am. A boat will be scored only after acceptance of a completed entry form. Acceptance of a boat's entry shall be contingent upon the completion of the entry form, and receipt of the required fee.

#### **4. ENTRY FEE & REGISTRATION**

4.1 2018 'Not Nude' Regatta entry fee is \$150 per boat. Checks should be made payable to the "San Diego Soling Fleet".

On-site registration will be conducted on Friday March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018, as noted above, at the discretion of local volunteers. Contact John Walton or Jon Mendham with registration questions (contact info below).

#### **5. SCHEDULE**

5.1 The Soling 'Not Nude' Regatta proposed schedule is as follows. The Race Committee may alter the schedule as needed.

Saturday	Noon	Race 4 followed by Race 5, 6, and 7
	6pm	Post-race party - Mission Bay Yacht Club
Sunday	Noon	Race 8 followed by Race 9, and 10 (no warning after 3:00PM)
		Awards ceremony will be held as soon as reasonably possible after the last race.

5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Friday is 11:55 AM PDT, subsequent races to follow. No race will begin after 4:00 PM. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday and Sunday is 11:55 AM PDT. No race will begin after 3:00 PM on Sunday.

#### **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available Thursday March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 in the Soling storage area at Mission Bay Yacht Club, or at registration on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

#### **7. Inspection and Measurement**

7.1 At the discretion of the Regatta Committee, all entrants are, at the time of registration or any time during the event subject to (a) measurement of hull, rigging and sails and (b) inspection of required safety equipment. Failure to pass a measurement or equipment check after the event has commenced will result in disqualification of all races up to the time of detection.

#### **8. Venue**

8.1 Participants will compete on a course of type and location to be determined by the Race Committee on the morning of each day of racing.

#### **9. Courses**

9.1 Soling course details and diagrams will be published in the 'Not Nude' Regatta Sailing Instructions.

#### **10. Penalty System**

10.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS Rule 44.2, will apply.

## **11. Scoring**

11.1 A minimum of five races will constitute a completed regatta.

11.2 The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A, so that each yacht's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if six or more races have been completed.

## **12. Prizes**

12.1 Awards will be presented at MBYC as soon as reasonably possible after the last race on Sunday. Yachts finishing first, second and third in the Soling Fleet as a whole will be awarded prizes.

## **13. Disclaimer of Liability**

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.

## **14. Insurance**

14.1 Insurance is recommended, but not required for this event.
