

NOTICE OF RACE

Mission Bay Yacht Club Fleet 7

Lido 14 Fall Invitational Regatta October 13 and 14, 2018

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing [RRS].

2. Advertising

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class who propose to sail duly measured boats. Guests may participate to the extent permitted by the Lido 14 Class Rules and at the discretion of Fleet 7.

3.2 Any eligible boat may register as "Lido A" or as "Lido B". As participants check in, the selection of each boat will be displayed on a white board. Registrants may switch between "A" or "B" until close of registration. It will make for a better regatta if we can achieve approximately the same number of boats in each class; participants are encouraged to make a fair assessment of their abilities, the condition of their boat, and skipper and crew experience.

4. Fees

4.1 The fee for registration is \$40 per boat. It includes dinner Saturday night and one free drink for both skipper and crew from the MBYC bar.

5. Schedule

5.1 Registration will be open on October 13, 2018 at Mission Bay Yacht Club from 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

5.2 The scheduled time for the warning of the first race of each day will be 12:00 p.m. The second and third race of each day will follow ASAP. Three races are scheduled for October 13, 2018 and three for October 14, 2018. One race completed makes a regatta.

5.3 Unless otherwise signaled, Lido As will start first, followed immediately by Lido Bs. Two or more classes may start together at the discretion of the race committee.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be distributed at registration.

7. Venue

7.1 The races will be conducted in Sail Bay immediately to the east of the Mission Bay Yacht Club.

8. The Courses

8.1 The courses will be selected by the Race Committee from the most current Mission Bay Yacht Club Bay Course Chart.

8.2 The course to be sailed will be displayed on a placard on the signal boat no later than the Preparatory signal. [This changes Rule 27.1]

8.3 Lido As and Lido Bs may or may not sail the same course at the discretion of the race committee.

9. Scoring

9.1 Scoring will be as provided in RRS Appendix A.

9.2 There will be one throw-out if all six scheduled races are sailed. [This modifies RRS Appendix A, A2]

9.3 Lido As and Bs will be scored separately.

10. Prizes

10.1 Prizes will be awarded the skipper and crew of the top finishers of the “A” registrants and “B” registrants.

10.2 Winner of the Lido “A” competition will be awarded the Robert Lesnick perpetual trophy.

10.3 Winner of the Lido “B” competition will be awarded the Roger Patterson perpetual trophy.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1 The skipper, crew, and owner of each boat will, as a condition to participation, be required to execute the Mission Bay Yacht Club form of release of liability and hold-harmless.

12. Registration

12.1 Registration must be complete by October 13, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at Mission Bay Yacht Club.

13. Additional Important Information

13.1 Participation bonus: Each regatta participant (skipper and crew) will be entitled to one free drink from the Mission Bay Yacht Club bar.

13.2 Dinner: Fleet 7 will host a chili dinner Saturday Night. This will be an opportunity for the Regatta participants and friends to meet and greet. Take this opportunity to get better acquainted with your friends in Lidoland.

13.3 Housing: Members of Fleet 7 are offering housing to out-of town participants on an as-available basis. Contact Kathy Dryden at drydenkathy@me.com and we will see what we can do. Early contacts will provide the best chances for a fit.
