Pete Jefferson Regatta

** Practice for the Lido Class Championships **

Mission Bay Yacht Club

May 1-2, 2021

CLASSES: The regatta is open to all current members of the Lido 14 Class Association who propose to sail duly measured boats.

ENTRIES: Entry must be completed prior to 10:00 am May 1, 2021 through the MBYC signup website at www.mbycracing.com and add your name the Google Doc tab "5/1-2: Lido Inv." Any eligible boat may register as Lido A or Lido B. Registrants may switch between A and B until the close of registration. Participants are encouraged to make a fair assessment of their abilities, the condition of their boat and skipper and crew experience.

The entry fee for the regatta is \$0! Yes, this regatta is FREE!

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE!

Any skipper that races in the regatta will be given a \$20 discount off of their Registration Fee for the Lido Class Championships to be held at MBYC August 20-22, 2021. Said skipper must register for the Championships before midnight on May 2, 2021 to receive the discount.

SCHEDULE: A competitor's meeting observing social distancing will be held Saturday 10:00 am at the flag pole at MBYC. To reduce the size of the competitor's meeting, only one representative from each boat is to attend and all attendees are to wear face masks.

Target number of races is five (5) on Saturday and four (4) on Sunday. The first warning will be at noon both days for Lido As, followed by Lidos Bs. The start of the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the first race and so forth. A minimum of two races shall constitute a regatta.

RULES: The organizing authority for this regatta is Mission Bay Yacht Club. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing as amended and adopted by USSA, except as amended by the MBYC Sailing Instructions.

Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official notice board is on the south side of the MBYC clubhouse.

The minimum crew weight requirement as recognized by the National Lido Association of 300 pounds will be in place. To maintain COVID-19 social distancing, there will be no crew weight measured at registration but it is expected for teams to comply with the minimum weight requirements.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The racing will be in Sail Bay, just East of the Mission Bay Yacht Club clubhouse. The courses for these races will be prescribed in the sailing instructions.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists exist at MBYC and are available for launching. Overnight trailer parking is provided at the club. Check in at the front desk at MBYC for any questions and trailer parking location.

RECOGNITION & SCORING: All participants will receive a participation trophy provided by Lido Fleet 7. The winner of the A fleet will receive the Pete Jefferson Memorial Trophy. The perpetual trophy will be engraved at the expense of Lido Fleet 7 and will remain in the MBYC Trophy Case.

When fewer than nine races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. When seven or more races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all its race scores excluding her worst excludable score.

MEAL INFORMATION: Breakfast and lunch are available at the MBYC galley for a reasonable cost. Saturday evening, the galley is also open to order food. All seating is outside and social distancing is to be maintained. Tables are not to be moved and there are to be no more than six people at a table.

MBYC RESTRICTIONS: Motor homes or recreational vehicles are allowed inside the MBYC gate but no camping or overnight lodging is allowed within the club. No pets are allowed on the MBYC grounds. Empty boat trailers are to be parked along the west fence. Boats are welcome to arrive the previous week to set-up for the regatta.
